LIGHTING IMPROVEMENTS

Thanks to the Public Service Commission and especially Commissioner Skrmetta, the Recreation District received a grant to replace aged HVAC units in the lobbies of the 2 gyms, District offices and Castine Center with energy efficient units. The grant also included changing out all of the florescent lights in the Park, all roadway lighting and all sport lighting in the 7 gyms. The work will continue through the end of the summer with all the installations.



LOWERED TAXES

In 2019 the Recreation District #1 Board of Commissioners voted to lower their millage rate. The Board felt that it was important to always try to reduce the millage for the taxpayers. This coming year the District will assess a total of only 7.25 mils which is down .05 mils from the previous year. These millages pay for operational cost of Recreation District / Pelican Park / Castine Center.

SILVER COMPLEX RENTALS

The Silver Complex has three (3) rectangle fields and three (3) pie shaped fields. These fields were built as practice fields for both the District and public use. When not in use for our own programs, the Silver fields are available on a first come. first served basis when not reserved.

All Silver practice fields have automatic lights for night use. Push buttons are located on the light poles at each field. Once pushed, they give the field one hour of lighting. If you are going to be on the field longer than one hour, please push the button before your hour expires to extend your lighting time. If you forget, the lights will take up to 10 minutes to cool down then up to another 10 minutes to come back on.

Disc Golf is a flying disc sport in which players throw a disc at a target; similar to golf but throwing a disc instead of hitting a ball. Players complete a hole by throwing a disc from a tee area toward a target which is called the basket. The player with the lowest number of total throws at the last hole wins. The sports registration fees have been reduced an average of \$3.00-\$4.00 this year.





Pelican Play-up Policy

The Park no longer allows play-ups for leagues with combined age groups. This change is to keep with the philosophy that was set years ago by the Board of Commissioners that restricts three age groups, with the exception of high school age players, from playing together in the same league. The philosophy was established for player safety and development. This means that parents will not have the option to play their child up if the age group they are moving into already has two ages combined. (Example, a 10-year-old player could not move into the 11-12 age groups.) Play-ups to single age groups will remain a parent's choice.

Debit/Credit Card Information

Please note that when using a debit or credit card for youth sports registration, your card will be pre-authorized and your bank may place a hold on your account for the registration amount for 72 hours or longer for each registration you attempt. The Park has no control over how long your bank places a hold on the funds.

Refund Policy

Until team formation, refunds are given upon request less a \$5 handling fee. Between the draft and the second game, a refund request is not guaranteed. However, a refund will be issued during this time if a child from the waiting list accepts the open spot. When the waiting list child has registered, we will issue a refund to the child dropping from the league less the \$5 handling fee when the uniform, if already issued, is returned. After the second game of the season is played, we do not issue refunds for ANY reason.

Scholarships Available

The Park believes that all District children should be able to play sports regardless of their ability to pay. Should you need financial assistance with youth sports registration, please come in to our office and complete an application. Scholarships are available to District residents only and you must come in to our office to apply.

Secondary Medical Insurance

As part of your registration fee, Pelican Park purchases secondary insurance for your child for injuries sustained while playing in our programs.
