The playground features a Global Motion® from Landscape Structures appropriate for ages 5-12. Kids can climb, rotate, and explore two levels of climbing ropes on the inside or outside of this fun-filled globe shaped play equipment. We have a bobble apparatus for 2-5 year olds as well as 2 benches for parents to sit and watch their children play. The complete area is covered by ASTM safety surfacing to protect children in the event of a fall. Recreation District #1 is a free standing governmental agency. The District is supported by a property tax paid by the residents and business within the Recreation District. The general boundaries of the Recreation District are Lake Pontchartrain on the south side, the Thchefuncte river on the west side, Big Branch on the east side and Three Rivers Road on the north side. The District, which operates Pelican Park, is under the Direction of a 7 member Administrative Board and staff.

GREEN 5 REPURPOSE

The excitement and planning continues on the redevelopment of the old green 5 field and surrounding area. The archetects and engineers are scheduled to have plans finished and put out to bid in late September. The project which includes the construction of a pond, walking paths, 8 pickleball courts, horseshoes, bocce ball and shuffleboard courts and a parking lot, will be publicly advertised and bid according to public bid law. If bids are within budget, the project will begin late this year and scheduled to be completed by summer 2019.

PELICAN'S NEST SKATE PARK



Our skate park is located at the north end of Pelican Park and is OPEN from 7AM – 9PM every day.

The skate park is called The Pelican's Nest Skate Park and is recommended for all ages with several types of jumps, ramps and riding rails for beginner and intermediate skaters.

Bikes are permitted at the skate park during the following designated times:

- Tuesdays and Thursdays, 7-9 p.m.
- Saturdays, 7-9 a.m.

Pelican's Nest features restrooms, vending machines and lights for riding at night, too!



LOWER TAX

Recreation District #1 Board of Commissioners voted unanimously at their May board meeting to lower the tax millage rate assessed to property owners. This is the 14th straight year that the District Board has lowered the millage. For the 2018 tax roll, the District will be assessing a total of 7.30 mils, down .30 mil from last year. These millages pay for both operational cost of the Recreation District / Pelican Park / Castine Center, as well as the debt service on the loan taken to build the facilities.

DOG PARKS

Did you know that Recreation District #1 operates two dog parks? We have one in Pelican Park called The Bark Park that is a 4 acre complex that has both a large dog and small dog area.

Our second location is located just north of I-12 on Andrew Drive, near Home Depot in Covington. It is called Pretty Acres Dog Park and is a 1 acre dog park with a human walking trail around the outside. Bring your favorite furry friend and socialize with other dogs and other dog lovers.



DISC GOLF

Have you ever played disc golf before? Disc golf is a great family sport that's fun for all ages and abilities. Disc golf is played much like traditional golf, but instead of a ball and clubs, players use a flying disc, or Frisbee®.

SILVER PRACTICE FEILDS



We have six silver practice fields at the north end of the Park that are designed for first-come, first-served usage. The three pie shape fields and the three rectangular shaped fields all have lights for evening usage. The District does rent out the silver fields on a quarterly basis to travel teams for practice. One field of each type is always left open for first-come, first-served usage. The silver fields are perfect for pick-up games, family games, flying kites, remote control cars, one on one practice with your kids, etc. For the public's convenience, the silver fields have a pavilion with shade, bathrooms and vending machines.

The silver fields also have two sand volleyball courts for use by the public. Since this is a public Park, the fields cannot be used for commercial use without renting the fields. To rent a field, call Kia Knight @ 985-626-7997

Pelican Play-up Policy

The Park no longer allows play-ups for leagues with combined age groups. This change is to keep with the philosophy that was set years ago by the Board of Commissioners that restricts three age groups, with the exception of high school age players, from playing together in the same league. The philosophy was established for player safety and development. This means that parents will not have the option to play their child up if the age group they are moving into already has two ages combined. (Example, a 10-year-old player could not move into the 11-12 age groups.) Play-ups to single age groups will remain a parent's choice. Play-up requests to single age groups will be pending until leagues are formed.

Debit/Credit Card <u>Information</u>

Please note that when using a debit or credit card for youth sports registration, your card will be pre-authorized and your bank may place a hold on your account for the registration amount for 72 hours or longer for each registration you attempt. The Park has no control over how long your bank places a hold on the funds.

Refund Policy

Until team formation, refunds are given upon request, less a \$5 handling fee. Between the draft and the second game, a refund request is not guaranteed. However, a refund will be issued during this time if a child from the waiting list accepts the open spot. When the waiting list child registered, we will issue a refund to the child dropping from the league less the \$5 handling fee when the uniform, if already issued, is returned. After the second game of the season is played, we do not issue refunds for ANY reason.

Scholarships Available

The Park believes that all District children should be able to play sports regardless of their ability to pay. Should you need financial assistance with youth sports registration, please come in to our office and complete an application. Scholarships are available to District residents only and you must come in to our office to apply.

Secondary Medical <u>Insurance</u>

As part of your registration fee, Pelican Park purchases secondary insurance for your child for injuries sustained while playing in our programs. In the event of an accident or injury, you must contact the Park's office and complete an incident report. For more information, call the Pelican Park office at: 985-626-7997
