
OUR MISSION



Pelican Park and Partnerships

Why Become a Pelican Park Sponsor?

First, a little history The primary – and almost exclusive – funding source for the operation of Recreation District #1/Pelican Park (RD1/PP) is property tax millage. The first property tax millage was approved by district voters overwhelmingly in 1988.

The tax dollars allocated to RD1/PP are limited to use for construction and maintenance of the facilities and operations for the recreation district. Over the last 15 years, the RD1 Board of Commissioners has consistently reduced the millage rate for taxpayers while maintaining the quality of its facilities and programs.

The mission of RD1 has expanded significantly since its inception in 1986. In an effort to offer even more indoor and outdoor recreational activities for all ages, the Board, in 2019, approved a comprehensive sponsorship program that would 1) raise additional funds to invest in RD1/PP and 2) provide significant marketing opportunities for businesses that wish to show their support to RD1/PP, the residents the district serves, and the more than 1 million annual visitors to Pelican Park.

Where does the sponsorship money go? The funds raised through the sponsorship program will allow RD1/PP to invest in additional activities, programs, and facilities that would not be possible through the dedicated tax millage alone. Such improvements may include, but are not limited to:

- development of "showcase fields" that would feature artificial turf, grandstands, and scoreboards. Showcase fields of this caliber would help attract more outside tournaments to PP, which, in turn, would provide significant economic boosts for others (retailers, restaurants, hotels, etc.) in the area.
- expansion of programs and opportunities for the district's special needs population (adults and children).
- major repairs and enhancements to the Northlake Nature Center (NNC), a 200-plus-acre facility that RD1 acquired from St. Tammany Parish in 2019. The NNC is located adjacent to PP and currently features a kayak/canoe launch, biking and hiking trails, and more, and has a history of hosting events such as moonlight hikes, group paddles, yoga, and birdwatching.
- the construction of a golf driving range, a BMX track, an indoor shooting range, a drone park, an obstacle course, and a splash park.

With the recent acquisition of the 192-acre portion of Northlake Nature Center, Recreation District #1 land now totals almost 500 acres (Pelican Park is comprised of 231 acres and sits adjacent to a 55-acre tract that houses maintenance operations and was part of the former Southeast Hospital property). Already an amazing recreational space on the western side of St. Tammany Parish, Pelican Park and the surrounding acreage present boundless opportunity for growth and expansion to serve an even wider population of residents and visitors each year.

About Pelican Park Pelican Park serves the residents of Recreation District #1 in St. Tammany Parish and visitors from all over the country. The boundaries of RD1 stretch from Big Branch on the east side to the Tchefuncte River Bridge in Madisonville on the west side, and from the foot of the Lake Pontchartrain Causeway to well north of I-12 toward Three Rivers Road. Currently, there are approximately 75,000 residents within the boundaries of the District.
