

MAKING A DIFFERENCE FOR 30 YEARS!



Kathy Foley, Recreation District #1 Director, recently celebrated her 30th anniversary with the Park. Kathy, who had a degree in Recreation and Park Administration, was hired as the first Director of the Recreation District #1 in 1989. Kathy has made a difference in hundreds of thousands of families and children in this community and she has been a great leader in the growth of Pelican Park. Under her leadership, Recreation District #1/ Pelican Park has gone from 50 acres to 320 acres, soon to be 512 acres. We originally had 1 gym with 2 courts and now we have 2 gyms and 7 courts and a 46,000 sqft Castine Center. The Park began with 7 baseball/softball fields and now has 15 game/practice fields. The Park grew from 6 football/soccer fields to now having 17 game/practice fields. Congratulations Kathy on 30 years of service to the community! Kathy will be retiring on April 1, 2020.





SMALL FAMILY **GAMES AREA**

Your family would love to come hang out at Pelican Park's new small games area! This area includes two Bocce courts, two Horseshoe courts, and two Shuffleboard courts available for open play hours seven days a week. The courts are available on a first come, first served basis. Bring your own equipment or use the Parks equipment.

OUTDOOR FITNESS EQUIPMENT

The newest addition to Pelican Park is The Groves which has 9 outdoor fitness machines made by Greenfield Exercise Equipment. The equipment consists of machines that develop stamina, upper arms and body, legs and lower body as well as overall conditioning. The machines use your body weight for resistance. The Groves is a great place to get a workout while the kids are at practice or with the kids.

BRIGHT CHANGES AT PELICAN PARK

If you've visited Pelican Park recently you may have noticed some "bright" changes. The Park has received a grant to upgrade our lights in the Park to LED lighting. This Statewide Energy Efficiency Program (SEEP) grant funded new LED lights in all 7 courts of the Brown and White gyms as well as all roadway and parking lot lights. Work continues with replacement of the outdoor field lights on Orange 1, 2 and 3, Green 4 and Grey East/ West fields which will be done by March 2020.





The Recreation District bid out the replacement of the wooden poles at Orange 1 - 3 fields. The low bidder for the contract was, Frischhertz Electric Co. Work is moving quickly and Frischhertz. has already finished the demolition of 21 wooden light poles and installed all new underground wiring. The new metal poles are scheduled to arrive late in December and will be erected the first few weeks of January. Frischhertz is an excellent contractor who the Park has worked with before as they were the contractor for the installation of all the poles and lights on Grey 2, Yellow 1-3, Blue 1-3 and Purple 1-3 fields.

- Age as of 9/1/2019 (Must be 13 by 9/1/19)
 Practices begin Saturday, January 25th. (5 preseason & 1 season practice per week)
 Games begin Saturday, February 8th and may be played on any day of the week.
- 10 game season followed by a single elimination tournament
- 2 games per week, one weekday & one weekend (Saturday or Sunday)
- Evaluation schedule will be available at registration.
- Age 18 MUST be a high school student with a current school ID and must register in office with ID
- Players who are currently playing on a high school team (freshmen, junior varsity, or varsity) cannot participate in evaluations, practices or games until their high school season is complete, including play-off games. This is in compliance with LHSAA. If this policy is violated, their high school may have to forfeit all games where the student was included on the roster.

∙If your child plays on a high school basketball team we will make an exception to the playing cap rule ONLY if the Park receives verification that he is, in fact, on a high school team. This needs to be in the form of a letter by the head coach of the high school basketball team stating that he is, in fact, on a high school team. Verification must be received by Monday, January 20th by 6:00pm. This letter can be emailed to traciplaisance@pelicanpark.com, faxed to 985-626-9028 or the letter can be dropped off to the Park office.

Pelican Play-up Policy

The Park no longer allows play-ups for leagues with combined age groups. This change is to keep with the philosophy that was set years ago by the Board of Commissioners that restricts three age groups, with the exception of high school age players, from playing together in the same league. The philosophy was established for player safety and development. This means that parents will not have the option to play their child up if the age group they are moving into already has two ages combined. (Example, a 10-year-old player could not move into the 11-12 age groups.) Play-ups to single age groups will remain a parent's choice.

Debit/Credit Card Information

Please note that when using a debit or credit card for youth sports registration, your card will be pre-authorized and your bank may place a hold on your account for the registration amount for 72 hours or longer for each registration you attempt. The Park has no control over how long your bank places a hold on the funds.

Refund Policy

Until team formation, refunds are given upon request less a \$5 handling fee. Between the draft and the second game, a refund request is not guaranteed. However, a refund will be issued during this time if a child from the waiting list accepts the open spot. When the waiting list child has registered, we will issue a refund to the child dropping from the league less the \$5 handling fee when the uniform, if already issued, is returned. After the second game of the season is played, we do not issue refunds for ANY reason.

Scholarships Available

The Park believes that all District children should be able to play sports regardless of their ability to pay. Should you need financial assistance with youth sports registration, please come in to our office and complete an application. Scholarships are available to District residents only and you must come in to our office to apply.

Secondary Medical Insurance

As part of your registration fee, Pelican Park purchases secondary insurance for your child for injuries sustained while playing in our programs. In the event of an accident or injury, you must contact the Park's office and complete an incident report. For more information, call the Pelican Park office at: 985-626-7997
